K R A V I C E W A T E R F A L L S

B L A G A J B U N A S P R I N G

Blagaj is a picturesque village located at the source of the Buna River, one of the strongest karst springs in Europe, approximately 20 km south of Mostar. The river flows westward for about 9 km before joining the Neretva River near the village of Buna, creating a striking natural and cultural landscape.



POČITELJ

Počitelj is a historic town located 30 km south of Mostar, built during the Ottoman period in 1563. Its well-preserved monumental architecture and scenic setting have long inspired painters and artists from around the world.



T R A V N I K

Travnik was the capital of Bosnia during the early Ottoman period and served as the City of Governors from 1697 to 1850. Located 100 km northwest of Sarajevo, it is known for its mild climate, historic architecture, and traditional cultural restaurants.



V R E L O B O S N E

Located southeast of Sarajevo, Vrelo Bosne is renowned for its stunning natural beauty and tranquil surroundings. This iconic natural park is a beloved landmark for both tourists and locals, offering a peaceful escape into nature.



J A J C E

Once known as the City of Kings, Jajce is located 160 km west of Sarajevo, nestled in a mountainous landscape of waterfalls and crystal-clear ponds. It is uniquely distinguished as the only city in the world with a waterfall located at the very heart of the town, creating a truly picturesque and memorable setting.



R A F T I N G

Join an exciting rafting adventure along the Neretva River on a six-hour journey starting from the town of Konjic. The route passes through lush forests and dramatic valleys, with a relaxing one-hour lunch break on the riverbanks along the way.



B O S N I A N C U I S I N E

Bosnian cuisine reflects a rich balance of Western and Eastern influences. It makes use of a wide variety of spices, typically applied in moderate amounts to enhance rather than overpower flavors. Traditional meat dishes are mainly based on beef and lamb. Popular local specialties include ćevapi, burek, dolma, sarma, pilav (pilaf), gulaš (goulash), ajvar, and a diverse selection of traditional Eastern sweets.
